2.1 Thomas Fitzhugh, II was born about 1718 in Dorchester County, Maryland and died between 1793 and 1798 in Dorchester County, Maryland. He married Sarah Cannon about 1745 in Dorchester County, Maryland. She was born about 1724 in Dorchester County and died after 1798 in Dorchester County, Maryland. Thomas Fitchew and his wife Sarah purchased two negroes name Hannah and Drake from James Busick; Wit. 7/6/1793, recpt. recorded 1/5/1795. Around 2/12/1798 - Sarah Fitchew, widow, sold a negro woman Hannah and other property to Levin Fitchew. Thomas and Sarah Fitzhugh sold Cannon's Foundation at the head of Fishing Creek to Arthur Whitley and Edward White 6/6/1755 [7/7/1755]. No info as to how Thomas & Sarah obtained this land. Sarah Fitchew, widow, Bill of Sale for two negro boy slaves named Adam and Murray, to Henry Fitchew [not identified] 2/9 & 2/12/179. 20 pounds. Henry is probably the son b. 9/28/1774. He died between 1793 and 1798 in Dorchester County, Maryland.

He died on 12 Aug 1831 in Oglesby, Davidson County, Tennessee at 67 years 4 months 2 days. He had an estate probated on 17 Sep 1832 in Davidson County, Tennessee. He was married about 1785 to Lydia Ann Hopkins in Guilford County, North Carolina in the 1790-1800 census. She was born in Dorchester County, Maryland, the daughter of Earl Hopkins and Rachel [SUNK]. Lydia HOPKINS was born about 1765. They were living next to Erle Hopkins in the 1790 Guilford County, North Carolina. The deed records of Guilford Co. shows Samuel Fitzhugh sold land in 1802. Samuel and Lydia Fitzhugh moved from Dorchester County, MD, to Guilford County, NC, prior to the 1790 Census as did Earle and Rachel Hopkins. Eight children were born in North Carolina before they moved to Davidson County, Tennessee in 1803, settling on "Mill Creek" south of Nashville. Some family members say that they came with the wagon train of Capt. Williamson. Davidson County, Tn. deed records, Bk. F, pg. 322 show Samuel Fitzhugh from Robert C. Reeves, purchased -- 100 acres situate on the waters of Mill Creek, for \$500. 24 June 1805, rec. 21 Mar. 1806 -- Wit: Jesse Pate & David Sims. This property was 160 poles [east to west] x 100 poles [north to south] --- white walnut in the N.E. corner; Sugartree in the N.W. corner & S. E. corner; a poplar in Walker's line, S.W. corner. She signed a will on 8 May 1838 in Davidson County, North Carolina. Lydia died in 1839 in Davidson County, Tennessee. She had an estate probated Oct Term 1839 in Davidson County, North Carolina. He is buried in the Fitzhugh Family Graveyard. The Fitzhugh Family Graveyard is located in the 1/2 acre of the N.W. corner of a 100 ac. tract purchased in 1805 and is now part of the Christ Church Memorial Gardens Cemetery, 15354 Old Hickory Blvd., Nashville, Davidson County, Tennessee. A new memorial stone was added as a new 20"w x 30"h x 10" grey granite double monument with Samuel Fitzhugh. Noted: 8/24/2005 iaw HDD. Lydia Fitzhugh's WILL specified that a headstone & footstone be purchased for her grave and also a headstone & footstone be purchased for her son, Samuel Fitzhugh, Jr. The headstones for Samuel, Sr. & Samuel, Jr. are still there in 2001. Some descendants of their children, except Samuel, Jr., are known.
